This outstanding and very beautiful red carnival water set was made by Westmoreland exclusively for Levay Glass in 1981. The set was limited to 200 sets according to the flyers sent out by Levay Glass, but Westmoreland made quite a bit less than that during production. The exact number is unknown but a good guess would be less than 100 sets were actually made. The Levay flyers were all sent out ahead of time to see how many sets could be pre-sold, that determined the number of sets made. Making it even harder to find for the future collector.

The pitcher measures about 6 7/8 inches tall, it is a fat pitcher measuring 17 1/2 inches around and each tumbler measures about 4 inches tall. A truly rare water set in contemporary carnival...
