## PEACH OPALESCENT CARNIVAL GLASS ATLANTIS PATTERN

The cover picture is of the beautiful Peach Opal Carnival Atlantis Vases. These vases were made by Fenton Glass Company for M.L.T. Glass Wholesale Division of Carnival Glass Encore. M.L.T. is Dorothy Taylor's son Mike.

These vases were made in 1981. There were 5 pieces made. The shapes were Rose Bowl, Fan Vase, Hi Flared Bowl, Regular Atlantis Vase, and Spittoon. We have all but the Fan Vase. There was less than 100 of each piece made.

Fenton left off the spray on about 25 pieces. They have a clear bottom and Opal tops. These vases are very hard to find.

Mike had Fenton make some tiny pieces for him (two are shown in the picture, the rose bowl and the cuspidor). They used the bottom of the Beaded Fairy light and turned it into about 10 different shapes. The items made were flat cake plates, flared, ruffled, turned in, turned out, heart shape, regular shape, fan vases banana boats, etc. These were all made in Peach Opal about 691 in all.

Mike also had the Hobnail Compote made in Peach Opal. These were done in several different flares, shapes, crimps, etc.

These Atlantis Vases, to me, is some of the most beautiful glass I've seen. I hope you enjoy seeing this glass. If anyone has a Fan Vase for sale, please let me know.
