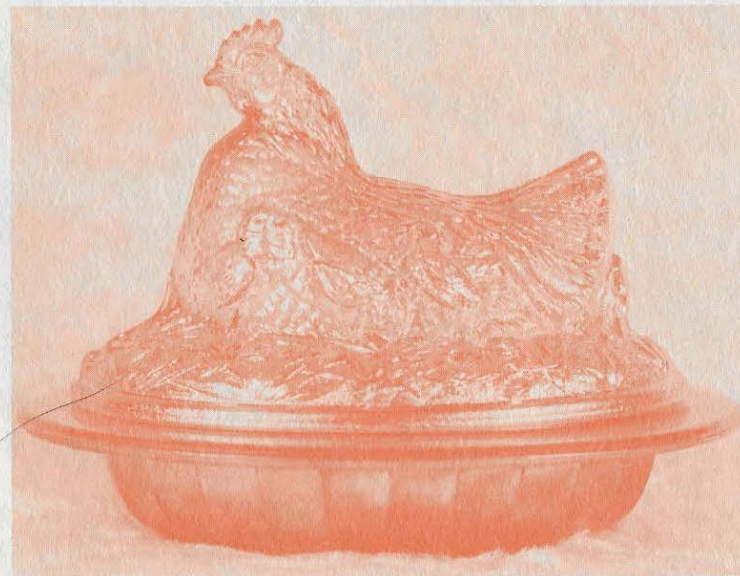

The covered hen is in two parts. Colors are marigold and purple. Some have rocks on side of cover and some do not. Probably two different moulds were used or two different manufacturers. Both types and both colors are of late manufacture and come under our modern carnival glass. However an old covered hen was made also. Manufacturer unknown.

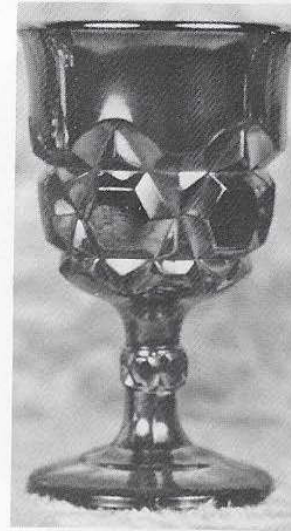
NOTICE

with little or no pattern.

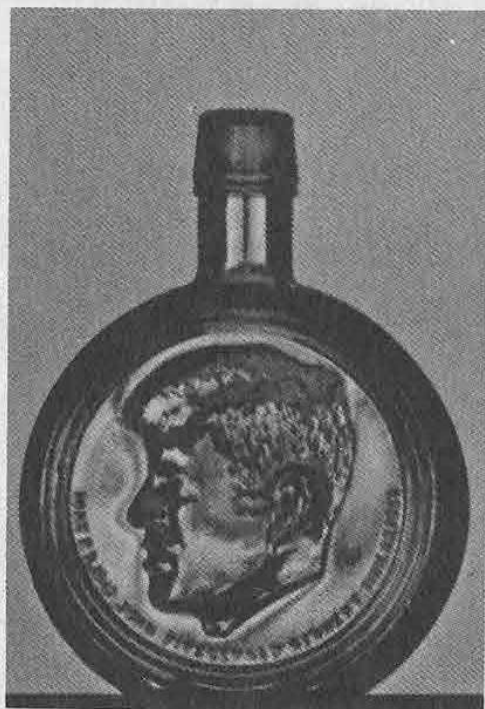
We hope we have been a benefit to both new and old
