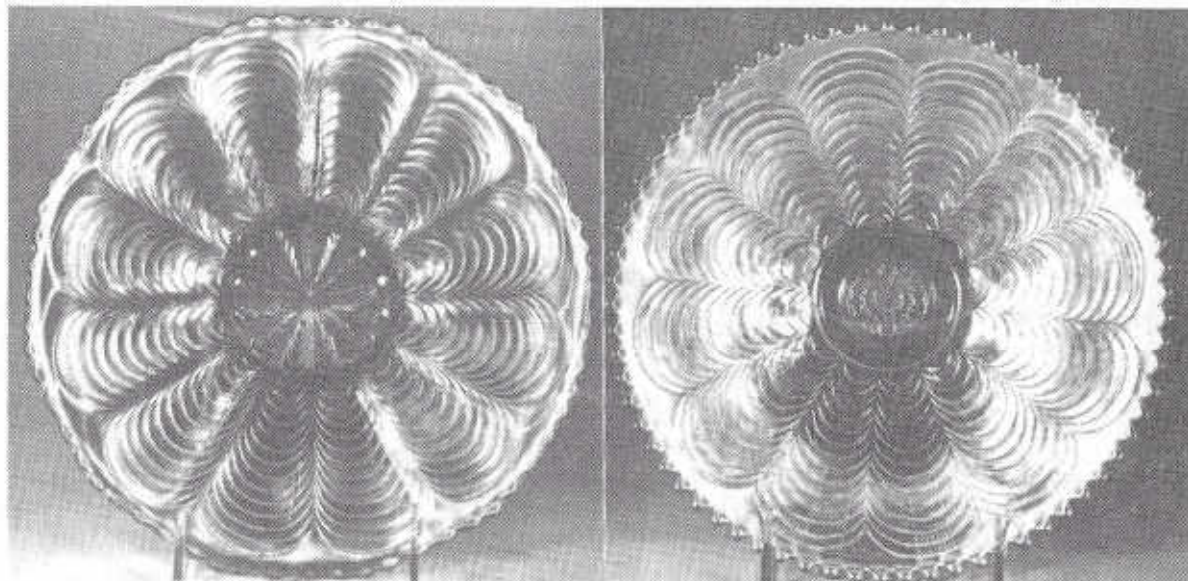

Carnival Cameos

PEACOCK TAIL (Fenton)

NIPPON (Northwood)

LOOK ALIKE PATTERNS

While these patterns are often confused with each other, when seen together the differences are obvious. The easiest way to remember them is that the arcs on the Peacock Tail continue to the very center of the piece whereas the Nippon has a stylized flower.

The 9" Nippon plate shown above is quite rare but does show up now and then in marigold (\$250-300) and in green or purple (\$300-375). I know of only one pastel plate in this pattern, a white one that sold for \$600 at the 1984 Mello/Laningham auction. Ice green and ice blue bowls are fairly prevalent but these colors apparently were not used for plates. Only 8-9" bowls and plates were produced in this pattern.

The 9" Peacock Tail plate shown above is the only one I have been able to confirm. A 6" plate turns up now and then and this is a common pattern on bon-bons, compotes, hat shapes and bowls of various sizes. Though it is much more rare, I am not sure this Peacock Tail plate would sell for as much as the more highly regarded Nippon.

RARITIES & SELDOM SEEN

Purple FASHION water pitcher and tumblers

In purple carnival, Imperial Glass Company has never been surpassed in color and beauty. This is certainly true of the above set and in my opinion, this is one of the most perfect geometric patterns with the "near-cut" being very deep and attractive.

I would rate this pitcher and the tumblers as very rare. For a long time this pattern and color was ignored and down graded, but not any more. It has had it's day in the sun.

I have had a tough time finding three tumblers and am trying for four, but haven't been successful yet. These tumblers are certainly hard to come by.

The Fashion pitcher will sell in the \$1000 bracket and the tumblers will bring around \$400. I have heard by the grapevine that about two years ago a purple tumbler in this pattern sold for \$700 privately.



WILD BERRY POWDER JAR

The "Wild Berry" pattern is sketched and described in Hartung book 4, page 78. It is shown without the cover in that book. I have seen two of these little carnival glass jars without the lid and have heard of one in crystal also minus the cover. This is the first one of these that we have had the privilege to see that was complete with the top. It is not surprising that so many of these do not have the cover since it would be so easy for them to get knocked off and broken. For that matter, we also see a good many Grape & Cable, Vintage and Orange Tree powder jars without covers.

This piece is slightly over two and one half inches high with a base diameter of two and three quarter inches. The top measures three inches wide with the lid intact. The bottom of the base contains a large rayed star pattern that covers almost the entire base. This particular piece was used as a souvenir. On the top of the cover is stenciled the words "PRINGHAM THE COUNTY BEAT". We have learned that this town is in O'Brien county in the state of Iowa. The town of Pringham and O'Brien county are northeast of Sioux City and rather close to the Minnesota state line.

While I can find no information as to the maker of this little covered jar, I would guess a company such as U.S. Glass, McKee or Westmoreland. This is a cute and interesting little piece of carnival glass and would be especially interesting and desirable for either miniature or souvenir collectors. Lucile does collect miniatures in carnival glass and she is quite proud of this one.



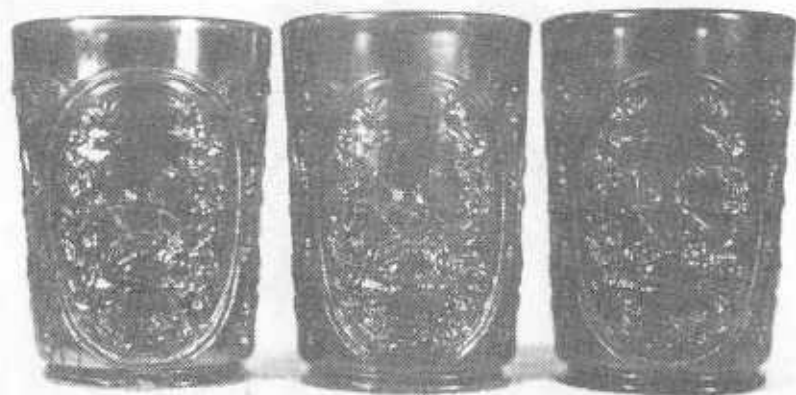
HONEYCOMB & CLOVER Spooner in Marigold

This is a pattern that many collectors have probably never seen where it was used as the dominant theme in a piece of carnival glass. Fenton Art Glass Company did use this pattern on the reverse side of "Feathered Serpent" bowls. We show here the marigold spooner that is part of the four piece table set in the "Honeycomb & Clover" pattern. It would be great to own a complete table set in this pattern but this is the only piece I have seen in carnival glass. No doubt there are other pieces out there somewhere, but I suspect this pattern was never produced in any great quantity in carnival glass.

William Heacock shows the "Honeycomb & Clover" water pitcher and tumbler in green opalescent glass (not carnival) on the cover of his book "Fenton Glass - The First 25 Years". The complete table set in green pressed glass decorated with gold is illustrated on page 31 of that fine book of early Fenton glass.

Oh what I wouldn't give to find a marigold carnival glass tumbler in this pattern! We are fortunate to own a beautiful "Honeycomb & Clover" tumbler in blue opalescent glass, but of course that is not carnival. Anyway, this spooner is a very nice and unusual piece of old carnival glass. Does anyone out there have any other table set pieces in this pattern?

Marigold is the color that is most often found in this pattern. In fact, "Windmill" tumblers in this color are both plentiful and inexpensive, even today. The marigold water set had to have been a great seller for Imperial Glass Corporation because they sold so many of the in this color. Even though the marigold tumblers and water sets in this color are common, they are certainly pretty and indeed collectable. On the other hand, the purple water sets and tumblers in this pattern are far from being common.. They are considered very desirable by collectors everywhere and we personally think that they are absolutely gorgeous. They are so outstanding that I have never understood why Imperial did not make more of them. However, we must remember that back in the days when this pretty iridised glass was being made, our homes were much more dark and it could have been that homemakers chose the marigold color to help brighten up their kitchens and dining rooms. In my opinion, Imperial made some of the very finest purple carnival glass. These "Windmill" tumblers and water sets are fine examples of this purple color. It would not be easy for anyone to go out today and find a purple "Windmill" water set that was for sale. The purple tumblers are highly sought after and nearly always have outstanding iridescence. Helios green is another color that can be found in this pattern. We have noticed that these helios tumblers, while not being rare, are rather scarce today. While they certainly are nice, they do not enjoy the great appeal or top market value of the purple water sets and tumblers.

About six years ago we were fortunate enough to find one of these old "Windmill" tumblers in the true Snokey color. While it did not have the terrific iridescence of the purple examples, it had to be extremely rare as I have not seen another one since in that color. We recently located a "Windmill" tumbler in lavender which also has to be a very rare color in that pattern. A blue one is known to exist and it would be quite

possible that there could be a few amber tumblers out there somewhere. This is especially true since Imperial made more amber carnival glass than any other factory and amber tumblers are known to exist in other Imperial patterns such as Field Flower, Imperial Grape and Lustre Rose. However, amber colored tumblers are seldom seen in any of these patterns and they too, are highly sought after.

It should also be mentioned that Imperial chose to reproduce the "Windmill" water sets in the 1960's in what they call Rubigold and Peacock. We carnival glass collectors know these two colors as marigold and sooke. Later they brought this pattern out in marigold with the sanded panels and produced this set for a number of years. No doubt, these reproductions hurt the desirability of this pattern somewhat, especially when they first came out. Generally speaking, it now seems most collectors are not too concerned about this since it is quite easy to tell the difference between the old and the new. The new tumblers have that somewhat heavier feel and all the new ones I have seen have the superimposed "I.G." on the inside bottom of the base. Even the new tumblers are quite collectable today and I have viewed a number of very fine collections of the so called "new carnival glass" tumblers.

In conclusion, I would say that tumblers in the "Windmill" pattern, even though common in marigold, have fine detail and are very artistic. The pattern somewhat reminds one of Imperial's beautiful NuArt Homestead plates. I think the purple tumblers are fantastic examples of this pattern. You will find "Windmill" tumblers very hard to locate in the colors of sooke, lavender and blue. You might even look for one in amber or clambroth because it is possible that they might exist in these colors.

This article is our 84th edition in this "Educational Tumbler Series". Next month we will cover a Fenton pattern that is most often called "Fluffy Peacock" by carnival glass collectors today.

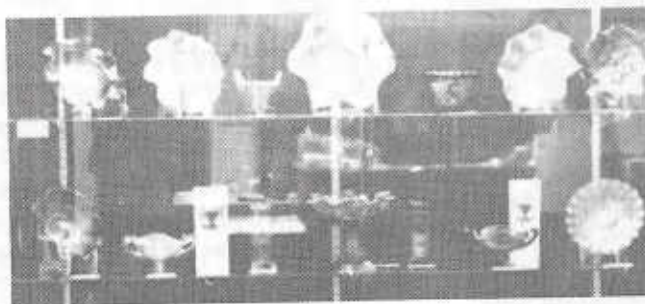
