Dear Michael:

Regarding the white carnival vase that was pictured and that Leslie Martin inquired about in the July issue of the H.O.A.C.G.A. Bulletin, it is of recent manufacture.

The L. E. Smith Glass Co. made it in several carnival colors, including white, which they called Crystal Luster. Among new carnival collectors, it is referred to as a Corn Vase. If Ms. Martin will look closely on the base of her vase, I'm sure that she will see an embossed S which is the logo of the Smith Glass Co.

Interestingly enough, Imperial apparently "borrowed" this mold from L. E. Smith in the early 1970's and produced it in cobalt blue carnival (called Aurora Jewels) and used their IG logo on it. The mold was obviously returned to L. E. Smith which subsequently used it to produce other carnival colors.

## EDUCATIONAL TUMBLER SERIES By John & Lucile Britt



IMPERIAL FLUTE TUMBLER

The "Imperial Flute" tumbler is the tall example that is shown above on the right. This one is not listed in Owens' tumbler book. "Flute #3" (Owens' #66) is on the left and is considerably shorter in height. Essentially these two tumblers, both made by the old Imperial Glass Corporation of Belaire, Ohio, could be called by the same name. Each one has the collar base. Both show nine flutes that go around the outside of the tumbler and both contain a sixteen point star on the bottom of their base. There is enough differences between the two tumblers however, that I think we should call them by different names. In the first place, the "Imperial Flute" is a much taller piece of glass being more of a lemonaide type tumbler. It stands a full five inches tall while the "Flute #3" is of the standard table size. Secondly, the "Imperial Flute" tumbler is signed with the old German Cross mark IM PE which is placed on the inside bottom of the base.

RIAL

No regular "Flute #3" tumbler has ever been found with this old Imperial mark. Thirdly, the "Flute #3" is flared out at the top while the "Imperial Flute" has straight up sides.

#### Educational Tumbler Series continued

Fourthly, while both tumblers have the collar base and contain the same star design on the bottom, "Imperial Flute" tumblers are somewhat smaller in both these characteristics. Another difference is that while the "Imperial Flute" is found only in marigold, the "Flute #3" is known in marigold, purple, green, and very rarely in blue and aqua colors.

I might add that the Colonial Stretch pattern (Owens' #198) is also made in this same type with the nine flutes, collar base and the sixteen pointed star on the bottom of its base. These are also Imperial tumblers and are usually found in the stretch glass colors of celeste blue, white and the rare red amberina. Imperial Colonial Stretch tumblers are larger and even a little taller than the "Imperial Flute" tumblers that we feature in this article.


The "Imperial Flute" tumbler marks our 115th entry into this tumbler series. Next month we will feature the "Engraved Daisy" tumbler.

## PICTORIAL PATTERN PARADE By John & Lucile Britt




#### ROSE GARDEN ROSE BOWLS

The very pretty "Rose Garden" pattern was made by the Eda Glassworks of Sweden. For many years carnival glass collectors here in the U.S. considered foreign made carnival glass as being either English or Australian. Through extensive research by such researchers and collectors as Ray Notley and Marion Quintin-Baxendale, we have found that carnival glass was produced in many other countries such as Finland, Czechoslovakia, Sweden and Argentina, just to name a few. Most of this foreign made carnival glass was produced in the 1920's and 1930's, which was much later than our American made carnival glass enjoyed its great popularity. Probably the most often seen pattern in carnival glass that was made by the Swedish Eda Glassworks is "Curved Star". It too was once thought to be English. I believe the prettiest and probably the most valuable piece that we have seen in the "Rose Garden" pattern is the milk pitcher in blue. Another very rare piece in this pattern is the butter dish. A very pretty vase has also been reported in this pattern. The only colors made by this company were marigold and blue.

Back to our featured "Rose Garden" pieces that are shown above. The small rose bowl on the left is quite small, being only  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " tall with a top opening of  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". The base is  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter. The color is a good dark marigold.

The larger example, shown on the right, stands  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " high with a base diameter of 3 3/4". This one is in a rather light blue color base glass. Both pieces have a 16 point star-like figure pressed into the bottom of their base. The little marigold "Rose Garden" example is the only piece that we have seen in this shape and color.




