

THE BROOKLYN JUICE TUMBLER

The Brooklyn tumbler is part of a grape juice set that was made by the Fenton Art Glass Company of Williamstown, West Virginia. Like the pretty Concave Diamonds, Colonial Stretch, Satin Jewels and Pastel Panels tumblers, the Brooklyn is of the iridised stretch glass type of glass. Being a juice glass, its dimensions are rather small. They are 3.5/8" high, 2.1/8" across the top & with a base diameter of $1\frac{1}{2}$ ". The only colors we have seen in these tumblers are celeste blue and florentine green. The surface is smooth and contains no pattern.

Rose Presznick shows this tumbler & pitcher in her book three on plate #16. It is listed as #11 in Richard Owens' Carnival Glass tumbler book. William Heacock illustrates this small pitcher as #398 in his popular book "Fenton Glass - The First Twenty-Five Years." The color shown is in florentine green & is listed as a grape juice pitcher. The pitcher is also shown in two colors on page 91 in one of the old Fenton catalogue reprints. Unfortunately none of those old Fenton catalogues were dated before 1932, but Heacock states that his "educated guess" would place the circulation of this pattern in the 1921 era.

The Brooklyn juice tumbler is #167 in our Educational Tumbler Series. Next month we will feature Fostoria's beautiful Brocaded Acorns tumblers.

PICTORIAL PATTERN PARADE By John & Lucile Britt



OHIO STAR - COMPOTE AND VASE

Shown above is a tall Millersburg Ohio Star compote alongside the very popular vase of the same pattern. These Ohio Star compotes seem to be very rare. We collected Carnival Glass for many years before we ever saw one. After many miles traveling and searching, we were able to purchase one at the Don Doyle auction at Milwaukee, Wisconsin in June of 1990.

The compote that we feature here is $8\frac{1}{2}$ " high. The top is 7" wide with a base of 4 3/8" in diameter. The bottom of the base contains the typical large Millersburg 6 pointed star. The stem is tall and consists of 6 panels that are $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. These panels start at the bottom of the bowl and run down the stem to the base. The bowl consists of 3 of the 6 pointed stars and between each of the stars is a football shaped design that is nearly always used in the Ohio Star pattern. The only color that we have seen in this compote has been marigold. Millersburg compotes are considered rare in any pattern and this one certainly would be in that class.

This is our 155th entry into our Pictorial Pattern Parade. Next month we will feature the beautiful and very rare Millersburg Fleur de Lis rose bowl.

Dear Fellow Collectors:

Can anyone help me? My daughter is on a years exchange visit to the University of Wisconsin at LaCrosse. I hope to visit her next April for three weeks over Easter. Is there anyone in that area who would let me visit and see their collection of glass?

I belong to the Carnival Glass Society (U.K.) and have been collecting now for about 3 years. We often visit one another here for private sales or just to admire and learn, but obviously America is the home of Carnival Glass, so I hope to see many pieces not available in this country.

I do hope to hear from someone.

It might be argued that the Bud Vase Whimsey (so named by Sherman Hand) is stretch, rather than Carnival Glass. True, it has no interior or exterior pattern, and some examples of it—the pastel ones—have that "stretchy" look. Still, they are usually considered Carnival Glass, since they are found in the array of colors—marigold, cobalt blue, white, ice blue (or celeste blue), ice green and red associated with Carnival Glass. It also seems quite possible that they were also made in other vivid colors, especially dark green and purple/amethyst, perhaps others.

The Bud Vase Whimsey stands about $5\frac{1}{2}$ " tall, but the height may vary somewhat, depending on the formation of the top edge. Four top edge formations are known: jack-in-the-pulput, two sides up, four sides up (in a sense, square), and ruffled (apparently six ruffles in all instances). Evidently, they were made by Fenton, as one with a square top is found in an early Butler Bros. catalog, with other pieces produced by that Company.

The Bud Vase Whimsey is unusual because there is so much upper "lip". Those which are most flared out are nearly as wide (at the widest point) as they are tall. For what flower they may have been intended is unknown, but wouldn't sweet peas look pretty in a cobalt blue or in one of the pastel colors?

None of them are seen very often, although the cobalt blue and marigold ones are probably seen more often than the others, in that order. The pastel Bud Vase Whimseys are scarcer, with the white one somewhat more difficult to find than either the celeste blue and ice green. Whether there is more than a single cherry red one is not known.

The author would like to know if the Bud Vase Whimsey is known—and would like to buy them—in vivid and pastel colors other than those listed above. In addition, the author would appreciate the reporting of the edge formations known in each of the colors that are available. Please see the accompanying table for a listing of shapes currently known—and not known—in each color.

NOVEMBER 8 & 9, 1991: New Philadelphia, Ohio. A half-dozen Ohio collectors got together a very nice, well diversified group of glass for Tom Burns to sell at the auction. The owners advertised the auction in local papers as well as in the Antique Week paper and the large crowd was a reward for their efforts. Some 110 bid numbers were issued. There were several people in attendance which the "Old Timers" didn't recognize which, in our opinion, proves that the advertising paid off. Whether old collectors or new, we need

A Dahlia table set was advertised but one piece didn't survive the trip so the remaining pieces were sold separately and we were able to buy the one piece we needed to complete our set. The piece that would match our set had eluded us for years so we left happy.

NOVEMBER 16, 1991: An auction in New Haven, Indiana which included 140 pieces of Carnival Glass. Only a couple of miles from our home but would you believe we didn't attend. Had to be out of town on business on the one time in years there was a sale close to home. Don't know who owned the glass but heard there was quite a bit of damage.

NOVEMBER 17, 1991: Centerville, Indiana. Large auction of quilts, Hummels, furniture, Fiesta ware (1,500 pieces), R. S. Prussia, pottery and 112 pieces of Carnival Glass mixed in. Mixed in was the word for it as the Carnival was scattered throughout the sale. Some Carnival was sold in "lot" groups and bidders had to buy the unwanted pieces to get the one they came for and at bid price times the number of pieces.

There were 11 Poppy Show and Rose Show plates and bowls that sold individually and were the stars of the Carnival Glass. The green Rose Show bowl sold for \$3,000.00 after lively bidding by several people. Some other prices included two marigold Rose Show bowls at \$500.00 each, two marigold Poppy Show bowls at \$700.00 each, amethyst Rose Show plate at \$1,300.00 and the amethyst Colonial Lady vase at \$725.00.

Regardless of the catagory the better items sold for top dollar in our opinion. It was interesting to see a stack of 34 yellor or a stack of 31 blue or 44 green or 32 red Fiesta plates, etc. sold per each and no "take your choice" just take the whole stack. A little different than selling Carnival Glass plates!

Only 95 miles from home but the return was slow as one stretch of highway was glazed over and very slick. Saw several accidents. Just reminded us why our auction travels are coming to a halt for the winter.

A nice crowd came and believe about 65 or so bidding numbers out. Lots of write-in bids too. Good prices mostly on the rare pieces. Grape & Cable master punch set was high at \$2,600.00. A beautiful electric blue Rose Show plate at \$2,500.00.

We decided to leave before the end of the sale and to get home by dark. Never did hear gross amount. After it being above 90° only 3 days before, it was cold enough to put the furnace on when we got in. We enjoyed the trip very much.

On October 18 & 19 the Mid-Atlantic Carnival Glass Jamboree auction was being held at the Best Western Venice Inn at Hagerstown, Maryland, so since the pretty fall weather was still holding, we left on the 18th for it. Nicest fall days ever and foliage about as colorful as the Carnival Glass. Just beautiful in every direction. We picnicked at a Maryland park in complete comfort and were at the motel by about 2:00 P.M. As always lots of glass in many rooms. Saw several "old timers" in Carnival. The Ward Russels were just back from a trip and were doing the Hospitality Room which is always a meeting place for snacking and visiting.

MILLERSBURG HOBSTAR & FEATHER CUSPIDOR

This very unusual whimsey cuspidor was formed from the Millersburg "Hobstar & Feather" giant rose bowl. It is in the purple color and has excellent iridescence. There is another one of these cuspidor whimsey's in a collection in Indiana, but this is the first one seen in this shape. Also seen are two of the "Hobstar & Feather" giant rosebowls that had been swung out and formed into a tall whimsey vase. There is also one of these whimsey's that was made into a punch bowl shape. Millersburg is well known for their whimsy pieces and these "Hobstar & Feather" whimsey's are just a few of them.

John Fenton, who was responsible for the founding of the Millersburg, Ohio Glass Company, might not have been the greatest business manager of the carnival glass era, but his ideas and imagination for producing beautiful patterns and quality glass was among the greatest.




