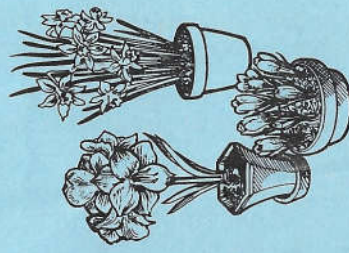

## EDUCATIONAL TUMBLER SERIES

### BUZZ SAW AND FILE JUICE TUMBLER

We wrote about the Buzz Saw and File table size and lemonade or ice tea size tumblers back in November of 1992. We were very surprised and excited to find several of the juice size glasses in this pattern. We had no idea that they even existed until we saw these. The little juices are 4 inches tall, 2 1/8 inches across the top and the base is 1 7/8 inches in diameter. In contrast, the regular table size tumblers are 4 1/2 inches high, 2 3/4 inches across the top and the base is slightly over 2 3/8 inches in diameter. The larger lemonade or ice tea size tumblers are 5 3/4 inches high and 3 inches wide at the top. The bottom width is 2 5/8 inches.

Two sides of the tumblers carry a large buzz saw whirling star figure with a hobstar at the bottom. The other two sides feature a hobstar, with smaller triangle file, cane and fan designs. All three sizes contain one of the buzz saw figures on the bottom of the base. We have also seen the water pitcher and goblet in this pattern. We suspect that the other pieces might show up in this pattern in the

future such as decanters and wines. Rich dark marigold is the only color that has been reported in the Buzz Saw and File pattern. The photo above illustrates the different designs used on these juice tumblers.

When we first saw two of the table size tumblers of this pattern in California in 1984, we suspected that they were made by the U.S. Glass Company. William Heacock later saw these same two tumblers and illustrated one of them in one of his Glass Collector books. He thought perhaps that U.S. Glass or possibly Cambridge could be the maker.

Most of the pieces found in this pattern have been traced to Argentina and Australia. We still lean to U.S. Glass as the maker, but can not be sure. At the present time, we are going to simply say "Maker Unknown".

These little juice glass are cute and dainty little pieces of carnival glass with very nice color and iridescence. The photos are courtesy of Dave and Joan Doty.

## ROYAL LUSTER CANDY JAR

Lorraine and I have been slowly building a collection of these candy jar or powder jar shapes for many years. We were delighted to find this very elusive example in a small antique shop in the Rochester, NY area last summer. This is a beautiful cobalt blue base glass Wide Panel pattern candy jar with a mirror-like quality silver iridescence finish inside and out. Made by the Diamond Glass-Ware Company.

The Dugan Glass Company of Indiana, Pa. became the Diamond Glass Co. in 1913 after the Dugans, Thomas and Alfred, left the company for greener pastures. Sometime in 1916 they had another name change to the Diamond Glass-Ware Company. They introduced their Royal Luster line of glassware in January of 1922. Several shapes are shown as well as the vase displayed on the front cover in **Dugan/Diamond** book "The Story of Indiana, Pennsylvania, Glass" by Heacock/Measell/Wiggins. This candy jar or powder jar, however, is not just a shape but carries the Wide Panel pattern. Some glass collectors among us seemed to bristle slightly when we displayed these Wide Panel powder jars at a HOACGA convention

two years ago. But we also had many favorable comments on the display.

Yes, these covered candy jars come in a variety of treatments of glass and were made in many colors by the big three glass makers. Fenton, Northwood and Dugan/Diamond all competed aggressively making these in sometimes very similar colors. However, the Dugan/Diamond firm introduced several glass treatments for these covered jars that the others did not venture into. Such as hand painted acid etched satin glass and two art glass finishes that were touted as reminiscent of Tiffany and Carder glass.

So although many of these candy jars are not iridescent glass, when you find one like this Wide Panel Royal Luster, that is a beautifully iridized, pressed pattern glass, made by a renowned carnival glass maker in the carnival glass time period, who can say it shouldn't be called carnival glass.

## PICTORIAL PATTERN PARADE

### THE FIVE HEARTS COMPOTE

In the November 1989 issue of the HOACGA bulletin, we wrote an article on the Five Hearts pattern featuring the rare rose bowl that we had just purchased. We still know of only two of these examples in the rose bowl shape. One of them sold at the 1993 Earl Bacon auction for \$1,500.00.

On November 27, 1995 we received a phone call from Pennsylvania regarding a compote in the Five Hearts pattern. Since I had never seen or heard of a Five Hearts compote, we decided to purchase it. It is so unusual and pretty that we thought it should be featured in our Pictorial Pattern Parade, thinking that other carnival glass collectors might like to know about it. Notice that it is made in the same shape as the Christmas compote. It is much smaller however, and the heart motif makes one think of Valentines day instead of Christmas.

The Five Hearts compote is 4 inches tall and 6½ inches across the top. The typical Dugan dome footed base is 3½ inches in diameter. There are five small hearts on the interior of the bottom of this piece. Five much larger hearts extend out from then and upward. Each of the five larger hearts contain a pretty daisy type flower, stem and leaves. The background on all of the hearts is stippled. The pattern is on the interior of the piece, but it shows through the glass from the outside very well. The color of this piece is very nice marigold with excellent iridescence.

Marion Hartung, in her book #8 on page 59, shows a sketch of the Five Hearts pattern which illustrates the pattern very well. In her 1981-1982 price guide, she mentions only the dome footed bowls, so at that time she probably had never seen the compote or rose bowl. We consider the Five Hearts compote as beautiful, rare and desirable. The photo is courtesy of Dave and Joan Doty.

This article on the Five Hearts compote is our 221'st entry into our Pictorial Pattern Parade Series. We hope that you have found it interesting and educational. Next month we will feature the Rose Garden pattern.

## VIDEO CONVERSION

Converting your living room into a film studio is not an easy task - nevertheless, it's what we had to do for the filming of our second video-book recently. Our first video - professional filmed by Angerton Video Productions - has been very successful and so we decided to proceed with the second in the series, called "*Hook on Carnival Patterns. Volume 1: Peacocks, Flowers and Fruit*". It's amazing just how much equipment is necessary: the overwhelming problem is the logistical one of how to accommodate a professional video camera on it's tripod, powerful floodlights, TV monitor (which shows exactly what is being filmed as it happens), adjustable boom plus a mountain of associated equipment in our standard British house. Cables everywhere to power up the equipment, ready to trip the careless! All this taking place around our Carnival glass - shelves, display units and tables... festooned with fragile glass. But as they say... the show must go on... we cleared as large an area as possible, set up the backdrop and the filming area, crossed our fingers and ...began.

Having worked with Angerton Video Productions before, we knew they have very high standards, but we had forgotten just what this means: almost every shot was filmed three, four and sometimes more times before all were satisfied. Our record was a maximum of almost 20 "takes" to get one particular shot just perfect. Some "live" shots have also been incorporated into the second video, which meant that an hour of filming and re-filming, getting angles, light and movement just right - is seen on the final, polished video as an episode lasting all of 10 seconds! We worked about ten hours on the first day, which we reckon condensed down to about 15 minutes of the video itself. Apart from the obvious hazards of all the equipment in a confined space amongst the glass, there were less obvious hazards too. Holding pieces of glass steady whilst they were being videoed is easier said than done, especially with the heat from two 500 watt floodlamps barely 12 inches away from you - not a comfortable experience: an alternative way to get a tan without going to the Mediterranean coast for two weeks!

Hmm. Well, if we thought the filming was hard work, the 'post production' surely was. Angerton have a great technical set-up for editing; they've achieved some wonderful visual blends from still shots into glass, that illustrate many of the contemporary, artistic influences on Carnival Glass designs and help to draw parallels between patterns. Then there was the narration to be incorporated live, followed by the addition of some really great, mood setting backing tracks. Finally, Angerton got a chance to demonstrate their skills with computer aided compilation... all we say is - "Don't miss the Carnival Glass reprise at the end!"

Having worked with us on two videos, Angerton's director, Robin Baumber, has now developed a "feel" for Carnival glass and its inherent beauty. The detailed close-ups and his lingering, detailed portrayal of some of the patterns enthralled him, and us too. We think that Angerton have also been converted to Carnival themselves. Although they are still a bit secretive about it, not really wanting to admit that they have caught the Carnival glass bug, they can now name and recognize quite a few Carnival patterns, appreciate the different colors and... have now begun their own Carnival Glass collection. They have their first piece - a marigold master berry bowl with a CURVED STAR exterior and a HEADDRESS interior. Truly a Video Conversion!

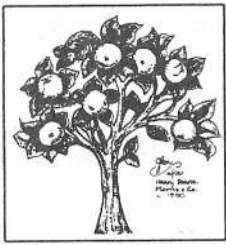
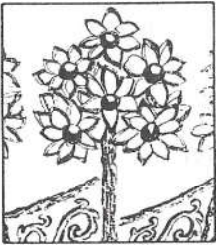
And speaking of conversions, Angerton also do video conversions so "*Hooked on Carnival Patterns. Volume 1: Peacocks, Flowers, and Fruit*" is naturally available in NTSC for the American market (but the PAL system for elsewhere). Come to think of it, we convert everything when we come to the USA - pounds for dollars, voltage for electrical items, driving on the wrong side of the road (sorry, the right side), petrol for gas, warm beer for ice cold.....

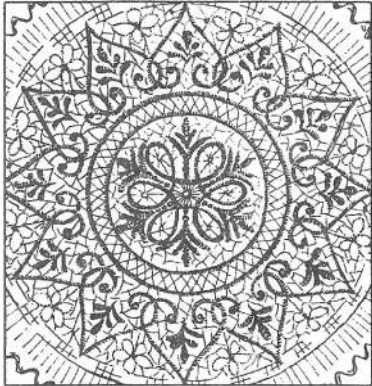

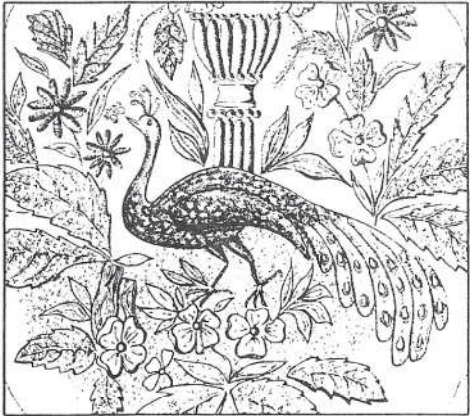

## AND THEN THERE WAS THE TIME...

No sooner had we joined the Nation's Capitol Carnival Glass Club, in 1968, than Ward Russell talked me into taking over as show manager for the club's annual Gaithersburg show. A true green-horn, I knew very little about antique shows and even less about running one. Ward assured me he would help... and he did. In fact, he did such a good job of helping me that I was appointed to do it again the next year.

One of the benefits of being a show manager is your name gets plastered all over the metropolitan area and people who want to know about Carnival Glass, or have some to sell, can just pick up an advertising card, with your phone number on it, and call you.

It was on the day of one of our monthly club meetings that I received such a call. A lady in Maryland had a water set she wanted to sell. Could I tell her how much it was worth?

This sort of question puts a collector between a rock and a hard place. I asked her to describe the pattern on the set. "It's green," she said, "and it has something like a basketweave at the bottom. And there are some flowers..."

The description didn't help a lot, but I guessed it might be Raspberry.

"Do you think I could get \$25.00 for it?" she asked.

"Oh, I'm sure it's worth more than that," I told her. "If it isn't damaged, you should get at least \$50.00."

"Would you be interested in buying it?" she wanted to know.

I asked where she lived. It was on the way to our club meeting, so I made arrangements to look at it. I had learned not to commit myself to a purchase until I examined the glass.

When we arrived at her home, and saw the water set, it was apparent that it was not the Raspberry pattern, but for the life of me, I did not recognize the pattern. The pitcher and five tumblers were beautiful and in mint condition. We bought the set for \$50.00.

Jim said, "Leave it to my wife to talk a seller up on the price and then buy it."

We took the set to the club meeting, where members showed considerable interest. One in particular, came up and said eagerly, "Do you want to sell it?"

I said, "Yeah, I'll sell it, but I'm still trying to find out what the pattern is..."

He hedged a little, laughed a little. "How much do you want for it?"

I didn't know... I had to think about it. My instincts told me to do my homework first. But another instinct said, "You can turn it over and make a profit for a few minutes work." At that time, the profit was more important than the research, so instinct number two won out.

Before we left, we'd made the man very happy by selling him the water set (without disclosing the name of the pattern) for \$75.00.

It was only after we got home and got out our Hartung books that we discovered that the water set I had bought, for \$50.00, could have had for \$25.00, and sold for \$75.00 was called "Springtime".

### IT'S IMPERIAL CARNIVAL TIME!

This busy day concludes at Undo's West Restaurant with a Banquet featuring speaker Robert Calhoun. "This glass was made by skilled artisans for the public and is collected by people, so the key to my presentation is not glassware but people. - \* The Convention offers members an opportunity to meet new collectors, renew old friendships and enjoy discussing carnival glass with other knowledgeable collectors.
- \* A banquet is held with a Carnival Collector as our Speaker.
- \* A Hospitality time is provided by the club. This is a time of relaxation and visiting with other members.

It takes the support of all collectors and members to promote the hobby in order that its growth and expansion can continue.

In order to obtain our objective, the members must financially support the organization. The Heart of America Carnival Glass Association receives its financial support through the Annual Membership dues and the sale of the following.

- \* **Membership Dues** - \$25.00 per year - U.S. & Canada. \$40.00 per year for Foreign. The Membership Year is from the date of joining to
