

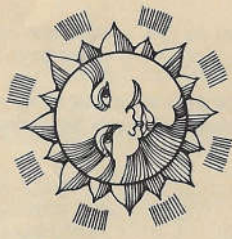
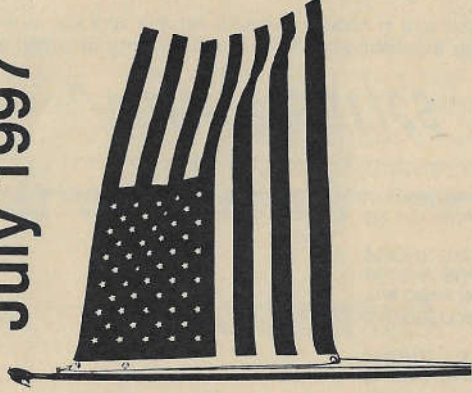
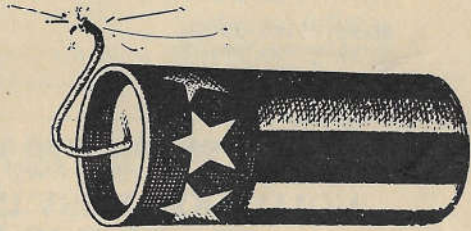

NORTHWOOD'S RUSSET GLASS

Iridescent Russet was added to the Harry Northwood's glass line in 1922. This was a distinctive new transparent color, nicely iridized and made in a wide assortment of shapes in what Northwood called their Rainbow Line of glass products. The color was missing from their ads by late 1924.

Two vases about 11" tall and various sizes of candlesticks seem to be the most seen items in carnival glass circles. A third 15" tall vase, mould #630 is listed in the old ads but we haven't found one as yet.

The two vases pictured are the Northwood's #989 swung vase on the left and the Four Pillars swung vase on the right. Four Pillars is found in many popular carnival colors. Concave Diamonds tumblers are also known in Russet but seldom seen. The Wide Panel powder jar, or jelly, mould #943 in Russet is also shown. This shape like the tumbler is not easily found.

Bill Edward's book suggests that Concave Diamonds shards were found at the Dugan plant at the Indiana, PA site. Concave Diamonds in Russet was unquestionably made in Wheeling, WV by Northwood.

This color can best be described as a pale olive green. We have sometime seen this color called citrine. Citrine is sort of a yellow green, leaning to the yellow side. More like Northwood's Topaz. However you may describe it, the color seems to be an exclusive Northwood color that was not produced by other glass companies.

ON THE AUCTION TRAIL WITH CHUCK

MAY 22-25, 1997: Keystone Convention. I always look forward to this convention. People make a convention, and at this one there is always a lot of buying and trading of glass as well as leisurely visiting in the rooms and hospitality room. I always expect this, and usually go home with a piece or set I really wanted. This year was no exception. I bought a marigold Circle Scroll butter - the first one I can remember seeing for sale. Now if I can just come up with the sugar and spooner!

This year the Keystone Club was blind-sided by a recent change in ownership of the motel. The restaurant was only open for limited food service at 6 P.M. daily. The banquet buffet was adequate, but when I sat down at the table I noticed a plastic disposable cup for the usual glass of water - to me this said a lot. One redeeming thing might have been the large and delicious piece of cake served as the dessert.

Burns Auction Service had a good auction for us in conjunction with the convention, and prices were generally above what they expected. Some examples were the \$1,350 electric blue 7 piece Peacock at the Fountain water set, the \$1,800 blue and \$1,500 marigold Good Luck stippled plates with ribbed exterior, \$3,000 9" white Persian Medallion plate, \$900 peach opal two handled Pond Lily bon bon, \$3,200 red 8½" Fenton Grape and Cable ball footed ruffled bowl, and the \$900 red Orange Tree shaving mug.

The banquet and white elephant sale is the fun time of this convention. What a pity many missed it this year. There was a mass exodus after the auction. This seems to be a trend at many conventions. Is the auction the focal point of a convention? If it is, maybe we need to rethink the schedule of activities.

JUNE 5-7, 1997: Lincoln-Land Carnival Glass Club Convention at Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Each carnival glass convention has its own personality and this year this convention moved up another notch. There was the super auction, many well-thought-out displays, a packed house for the banquet and everything well-planned. The hospitality room was well-stocked and open from early to late, and for the special events we moved across the hall to the "Annex" for the heavy stuff. Heavy like all the pizzas we could eat on Thursday evening, sandwiches and buffet Friday evening and the continental breakfast Saturday morning.

The real centerpiece, of course, was the auction of the Bechtel Collection, with some 25 items seldom offered at auction each bringing \$2,000 or more. Very good color and iridescence on a wide variety of glass - and very little damage. In my opinion, the Millersburg end was the strong selling part, and if you were a mug collector, you would have had a field day. The mugs were nice, and the prices were affordable. The total sale was a tad short of \$300,000, so there were not too many pieces that fell through the cracks.

What a job the Burns Auction team did this time! Don't let anyone tell you Tom and the Bills can't sell glass quickly and still get the desired prices. They were at their best this time.

MEET GALE EICHHORST

Gale has been into carnival for less than five years... but he has already become known to a great many of us. His enthusiasm is both refreshing and "infectious". At the 1997 HOACGA Convention his room display of Mikado compotes won the prize for "Same Pattern".

We asked Gale if we could include his experiences in this months HOACGA newsletter:

Hi! My name is Gale Eichhorst and I live in Mankato, MN. I spent four years in the Air Force stationed in Germany. I graduated from Mankato State University in 1974 and for the past 23 years have owned and operated a business selling and repairing vacuum cleaners and selling cleaning supplies and Watkins products.

I first became interested in carnival glass in the summer of '93 at local auctions. The auctioneer would say "carnival glass." I had no idea what or how old carnival glass was but it was pretty so I bid on it. Usually stopping when the price hit \$35 to \$50. I then bought my first carnival glass book by Edwards which had to be specially ordered by a local book store.

I struggled along finding a piece here and there until Fall of 1994. When I attended an antique show in Minneapolis. There I walked into Jim and Jan Seeck's booth. Wow! Carnival pieces at hundreds of dollars. I thought this must be "good" carnival glass. I purchased my first good piece of carnival glass - a powder blue Panther sauce. I asked if there were any carnival glass clubs and Jim and Jan got me to join ICGA, ACGA, HOACGA, and Lincoln-Land. Since then, I have also joined Air Capitol, San Diego, and a new glass club CCGA.

After joining clubs, I found that members could sell glass and I purchased my second piece of "good" carnival glass - an ice green Corn vase - through the mail from Tom and Sharon Mordini. I was hooked!

I then got on the major auctioneers mailings and attended my first carnival glass auction in January 1995 in Booneville, MO. I walked in and stood stunned

and Mickey Reichel came up and asked what was wrong. I said I had never seen so many beautiful pieces of carnival glass in one place before. Now I was really hooked and tried to attend every auction in St. Louis or Booneville that I could.

In April of 1995, I went to my first convention, HOACGA in Kansas City. WOW! Rooms filled with glass. People you could ask questions of. I was new - didn't know anyone and was waiting to go to the luncheon when JoAnn Ball came over and asked if I would like to join her and Cliff at their table. I said "Yes" and there I met and became friends with Elaine and Marty Benedict, Bob and Myrtle Lacock, and Don Lacock.

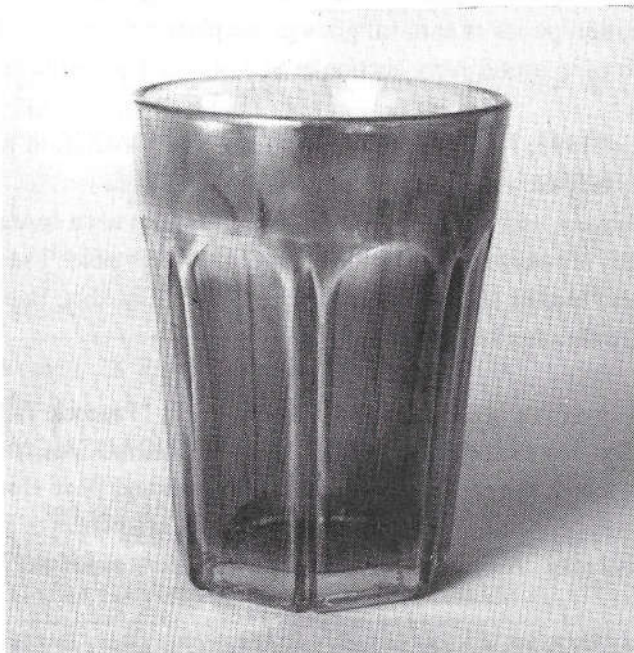
My collection is a general one but I lean towards "Peacock Tail", "Mikado Compotes" and vases especially "Ripple". My first HOACGA Convention was also special when I met and became friends with Joan and Dave Doty after they had given an educational seminar on vases with a large assortment of Ripple vases. WOW! How lucky. A seminar on vases and on my pattern Ripple.

The best way to get to know people is to share your glass. I went to the ICGA Convention in Dallas in August 1995 and took my first room display entitled "Carnival Finds 20 Miles From Home." I didn't have a very large collection but did get comments on my pair of smoke "Gothic Arches" vases. By taking room displays you find others who collect the same patterns and you all can share. What a fun hobby.

My best advice to new collectors is to join the clubs for information and then attend the conventions. Because that is where you have the time to meet and talk to people about our fantastic hobby of collecting carnival glass. That is where you develop friendships that span the globe from the USA to Canada to England to Australia. WOW! What a hobby!

EDUCATIONAL TUMBLER SERIES

PANELS AND SPEARS TUMBLER

The Panels and Spears tumbler was found by David Cotton of Mansfield, OH. At the present time, we have been unable to find the maker of this tumbler, but will continue to look of it.

The tumbler is of standard size, just a little over 4" high and 3" across the top. The interior and bottom of the base are plain. The exterior contains seven flute type panels. The pattern is rather unusual in that it has seven spears, one used between each of the panels. It is rather unique in that the spears continue' on through the base to the very bottom. The bottom of the base is slightly depressed, but there is no grinding or polishing on the underside whatsoever. We believe that the tumbler was made in the U.S.A. by one of the lesser makers of carnival glass.

This example is the only one that we have ever seen. Only time will tell as to the maker. It certainly is not as pretty as the Northwood's Wisteria, Fentons Lily of the Valley, Imperials Chatelaine or the Millersburg Morning Glory, but it is unique, different and would make a nice addition to any carnival glass tumbler collection. PICTORIAL PATTERN PARADE

CLASSIC ARTS POWDER JAR

The Classic Arts pattern is shown in Hartung book 5 in what most collectors refer to as a rose bowl. The powder jar is not mentioned in any of her books, but we have seen this Classic Arts pattern in rose bowls, several sizes of vases and the powder jar that we feature here. Ray Knotley shows the powder jar in his June 1986 Carnival Glass Society Newsletter.

Our featured Classic Arts powder jar is 5 1/8" high up to the top of the cover. The bowl part is 3" in height and is 4 1/8" across the top. The bottom of the base measures 2 1/4" in diameter. The outside of the jar and lid is made up of twelve slightly concave panels in very nice marigold. Over the top of these rather wide panels is a green stained 1 1/4" wide band that circles the piece at the top of the bowl. This band contains many figures of people dancing and playing musical instruments of different kinds. They appear to be having a very good time.

The Classic Arts pattern, along with a very similar pattern, that is known as Egyptian Queen, are considered to have been made in Czechoslovakia in the 1930's. The piece that we feature here came directly to us from England. It is the first example that we have ever owned in this shape. We believe that the Classic Arts powder jar is quite hard to find in the U.S.A. We have certainly seen more vases and rose bowls in this pattern than we have the powder jars. This statement does not mean that the vases and rose bowls are easy to find, however. Search for the pieces that you like and then buy and enjoy them.

This article on the Classic Arts powder jar is our 224th entry into the Pictorial Pattern Parade series. Next month we will feature one of our favorites - a beautiful marigold butter dish in "The States" pattern, a product of the United States Glass Company.

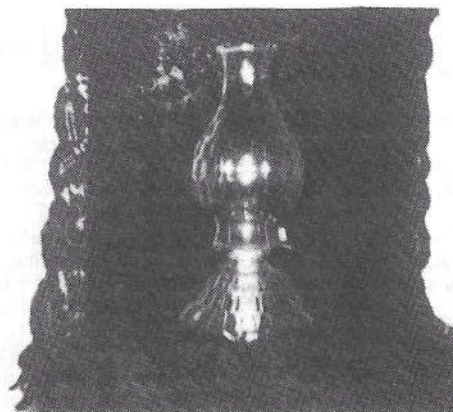
