

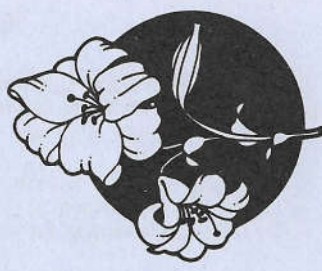

BUYING & SELLING - RETURN PRIVILEGE ADVERTISEMENT POLICY

One of the many benefits of being a member of HOACGA is the opportunity to buy, and/or sell, and to advertise in the monthly bulletin for pieces that you want. In order for this opportunity to be satisfactory to both the buyer and seller, it has to be one of mutual respect and honesty. To date, the officers of HOACGA have tried to set out some simple guidelines, so the buyer and seller can reach a mutual agreement as to the terms of the sale and purchase. Item #6 of the "HOACGA BULLETIN ADVERTISEMENT POLICY" states "A 5 DAY RETURN PRIVILEGE, AT BUYER'S EXPENSE, PROVIDING IT IS NOT AS ADVERTISED, OR AS DISCUSSED."

In the last few months, several complaints have been received regarding the purchase and returning of unsatisfactory and unacceptable pieces of glass. This subject was discussed at the Annual Meeting on April 23, 1998. Members in attendance generally agreed that those members who do not abide by the return-privilege policy should not be allowed to advertise in the bulletin.

Effective immediately, the HOACGA Board of Directors, in an attempt to deal with complaints, has adopted the following rules.

- If a member receives a piece of carnival, and he exercises his right to return the piece within the allowed time, the sender/seller is obligated to make a complete refund within five days after receipt of the returned piece of glass.
- If the refund is not made, the buyer can write a letter to the Board of Directors (Secretary) stating his complaint.
- This complaint will be reviewed and a letter will then be sent to the seller about the complaint.
- The seller will then be given ten days to notify the HOACGA Secretary of what action was taken to correct the complaint.
- If the complaint is not corrected within the required time, no further advertisements will be accepted from that member. Advertisements will not be allowed again until the problem has been resolved.

It is regretful that this type of action is required. It causes more work for those involved with the administration of the organization. We do not need to tolerate any unfair dealing among collectors/members. Carnival Glass collecting can only survive if members deal fairly with each other. **THERE IS NO PLACE FOR THOSE WHO WISH TO DEAL UNFAIRLY.**

ON THE AUCTION TRAIL WITH CHUCK

May 2, 1998: The ad said "Butter dishes EXQUISITE; china; carnival; etc." It was a Living Estate sale and I decided to go. Was this a chance that I might add to or upgrade my butter dishes? It was only 80 miles and my brother lived in the same town, so either way the day would not be lost. They had two butter dishes, one a beautiful china and the other just clear pressed glass - and no old carnival. I did find an Indiana Glass compote from the 70's, so the ad was technically correct.

I asked the auctioneer where the carnival was and he showed me two pieces of amber colored glass with no iridescence. I picked up the new carnival piece, poor iridescence and all, and told him this was what I was looking for except it had to be old. He didn't recognize this pieces as carnival and informed me carnival glass to him had to be orange colored. I stayed a half hour into the sale to see how he handled it. I must say he did a good job early on.

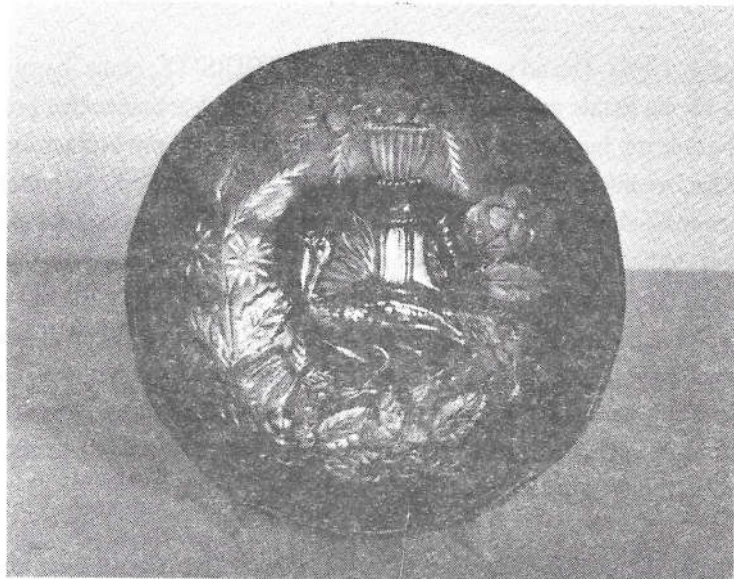
May 21-23, 1998: Keystone Carnival Glass Club Convention and Burns auction at Monroeville, Pennsylvania. This convention had a long run at Brookville, but a deteriorating motel forced a location change. In my opinion, the Holiday Inn at Monroeville was adequate, but change is hard to accept. The attendance was off somewhat and we missed many of the usual "regulars". I was offered a Hobstar Band spooners a piece I did not think I would ever see. Now if I can find the sugar and creamer.

The auction did not set any records and probably lacked super top-end pieces. Some prices were the blue Kittens cup and saucer (\$1,700), a too cheap green Wishbone pitcher (\$650), a rare marigold Garden Path Variant chop plate (\$1,700), purple Butterfly and Tulip square bowl (\$1,400), and purple 7 piece Greek Key water set at \$1,250. The one piece I went to buy didn't measure up so I did not even need a bid card.

While at the convention, I saw one of the two Millersburg aqua opal Ohio Star vases that Burns Auction Service will sell at the July 10-11 auction at Strongsville, Ohio. What a beauty and so very rare and desirable. I have a colored picture of the pair that makes me wish I was younger and rich!

PEACOCK AT THE URN VARIANT SAUCE

This sauce dish certainly qualifies as a Millersburg rarity. Marie McGee's excellent book on Millersburg Glass reports that only about six to eight examples are known to exist in amethyst. That translates to us that amethyst is the only color known. But hold on just a second for another new discovery in Carnival Glass. This sauce pictured, was sold without fanfare, last February by the Seeck auction team at the Texas carnival glass convention. *Listed as Lot 340: Millersburg Peacock at Urn IC sauce - horehound - odd color.* This ice-cream shaped sauce should be classified as *the sleeper* in this auction and was purchased by a very knowledgeable and well known central Texas miniature collector. A very nice addition to her collection of small but rare Carnival glass items.

This six inch sauce is reported as only known in this small ice-cream shaped dish. The sauce is quite similar to the Northwood Peacock at the Urn having three rows of beading on the urn, and displays the bee, but is not stippled. The reverse pattern is the standard Wide Panels with the many rayed star in the marie area. Again similar to the Northwood sauce that also carries twelve wide panels on the reverse. The Northwood sauce does not have the many rayed impressed star in the collar base and as a rule carries the Northwood signature, the circled and underlined N on a smooth base. The Millersburg variant Peacock also has some additional

flora to the left of the pedestal.

This sauce has the Millersburg satin iridescence finish. The color, described as a horehound, is also very noteworthy. Is this a rare and unusual color? We obviously don't know the answer to that. This was most likely an unintentional color variation, but it certainly adds to the desirability and mystique of the piece. And also adds another facet to the Millersburg story.

I have submitted a list of items for sale. Also, I would like to comment on the April 1998 article by Jerry & Carol Curtis. For some time, we have had a very deep Wild Rose bowl in dark amethyst. Dot in center alternating plain and stippled rays. Small mould imperfections. Otherwise exquisite. No (N).

Recently, I came across, to my delight, a flattened Wild Rose bowl. Flattened open edges. 50 or more plain rays internally with (N) centre. Iridised only on the center is marigold.

The legs are shortened to such a degree that the marie almost touches the table. The circle on the base is inside the legs. Due to the method of iridizing, I suspect this item to have been made by Dugan as many Dugan pieces show only internal iridizing. Also, the ball feet are built up to flatten off. The circle on the outside of the bowl extends out through the legs. It has definite ball feet.
