The information collected here is from various sources. (Thank goodnes for my habit of saving everything on the subject of carnival glass thru the years). It is taken from the plate survey done a few years ago by H.O.A.C.G.A; Hartung pattern books; and from our collecting experience.

A few years ago we bought a small collection of 25 pieces of Advertising an Lettered carnival glass in order to obtain the "Age Herald" 9-inch plate. This was back when we were mainly collecting plates and the people wouldn't sell the plate - - had to take all or none! Some of you are surely familiar with this procedure.

This list may be sketchy and incomplete by some standards. In most cases the shape mentioned is what was reported or what we have seen and know exists. No do there are other pieces of Carnival Glass with lettering, at least this will be an attempt to show that there really are a lot of them around.
